### **REHEARSAL TIMES and CHECK-IN:**

**Dress rehearsal is at Skyview High School. Please arrive PROMPTLY at 4:30 PM in costume for your first number.** We will have a parent meeting discussing the format of the show and instructions you will need to know.

**Please check the order of the song list, and be familiar with it.** Everyone will have a chance to work on entries/exits on stage with a quick walk-through of the routine and everything will be timed so that we have time for everyone. We will NOT do a final run-through as in previous years. Unless told otherwise, once your dancer has practiced all the songs he/she may be involved in, you are free to go home. This rehearsal is Mandatory so everyone performing will need to be there. (please note the schedule may be subject to change, but we will notify you—WE NEED SOME MORE PARENT VOLUNTEERS TO HELP. ### **PERFORMANCE DAY CHECK-IN TIME:**

The 12pm showcase, dancers performing in the 1<sup>st</sup> half, need to arrive **by 11:15p** at Skyview High School on Saturday and **check in with the Back Stage Coordinator (will carry a clip board)** to get lined up. The 3pm showcase, 1<sup>st</sup> half dancers are to arrive at 2:15p. For those performing the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of the show, you may sit in the auditorium until intermission. During intermission, 2<sup>nd</sup> half dancers will need to come backstage, check in with the Back Stage Coordinator and you will get lined up. After your performance, you may be dismissed to sit with family. (Dancers WILL need tickets, in order to sit in the auditorium, in order to have a seat reserved) We will walk younger students to the back of the auditorium **to be picked-up (if under 8 yrs old)**. We will ask all dancers to come up to the stage after the last song for bows and free-style session.

### **PERFORMANCE DETAILS**

1. **Please arrive in full costume, hair and make-up at SHOWCASE.** When on stage of any kind, make up is used to help the audience see the performer's face expressions better, as well as to be seen on the DVD, because the lights on stage are so bright, it washes out their faces. But it is at your discretion as a parent.
  2. Please make sure your costume is clean, ironed and altered (if needed). Add your own other accessories if you'd like.
  3. Hair needs to be styled (curled, crimped, braided, hat, bandana etc.) to your own preference, unless the instructor gave specific instructions.
  4. Please do not wear jewelry unless it is part of the costume. Leave all valuables at home as dressing rooms will not be secured very well.
  5. The first 3 groups will begin backstage. Each group will go backstage, 2 songs prior to your performance, but you will all be lined up in the order of the show. 2<sup>nd</sup> half performers, please arrive promptly during the release of the intermission. After performing, dancers may be released to go into the auditorium, if you are only performing one routine, otherwise you will go into the dressing room and change into your next costume. Tiny Tot, Boys Hip Hop & Pee-Wee parents, please come to the back of the auditorium and pick up your child after their performance.
  6. Before you go home, dancers and parents go into the dressing room, gather your/their belongings. We will not be responsible for anything left behind but you're welcome to check the school's or our lost and found.
  7. No flash photos or videos may be taken in the auditorium during the show.
  8. **All fees and tuition must be taken care of the week of the Showcase, in order to receive your tickets and perform in the show. You can pay by phone, or online.**
- **PRE-REGISTRATION for FALL classes** begins July 1<sup>st</sup>. Regular registration begins August 1st, so register ahead of time to reserve your spot in class., (classes fill up quickly)
